

Math 112 Information

USCL offers a 2 hour course called MATH 112: Trigonometry. The course contains all the information of Math 115 (PreCalculus) that is not in Math 111/111i.

Math 111/111i + Math 112 = Math 115.

- Students with a weak math background may choose to take Math 111/111i followed by Math 112 (5 or 6 hours total), instead of Math 115 (4 hours).
- Students who have had Math 111/111i and switch to a major that requires Calculus (Math 141) should take Math 112 instead of Math 115. Students cannot receive credit for both Math 111/111i and Math 115.
- Students who have a sufficiently high placement scores** may choose to take Math 112 (2 hrs) instead of Math 115 (4 hrs)
- Students who place into Math 141 but don't feel comfortable with trigonometry may take Math 112 to better prepare for Math 141.
- Currently Math 112 has low enrollment rates, giving the students more one-on-one time with the instructor.

**Math faculty members can answer questions about student eligibility.
