

Career Project

Paper & Oral Presentation

- 1. This is your major project & final exam. You will receive a maximum of 75 points for the paper and oral presentation.**
- 2. You will select an occupation for your career paper that you can go into from your current college major or one for which you indicated a high interest from the Strong Interest Inventory. Mr. Bonek must approve any career chosen.**
- 3. You will produce a 6-8-page research paper and a 4-5 minute Power Point oral presentation. The career selected must require a 4-year college degree for career entry. Each paper and presentation will include (but not be limited to):**
 - Career and occupation description
 - Degree, training and certification required
 - Values, personality & traits required to be a successful person in this career
 - Career opportunities available, job forecast regionally, salary projections
 - A profile of the college you expect to attend after USCL within the state of South Carolina. If interested in an out-of-state school, see Mr. Bonek. What would be your major at this school? What degree would you get? How much are tuition & fees, room & board? What courses are required for this major?
 - Why are you interested in this particular career? What strengths, skills, etc. do you have that will help you be successful in this career? Why did **you** pick this career on which to write?
 - Bibliography of sources used in researching this career.

Each paper should have a cover page to include: title of paper, name of course (University 101), your name and date submitted. Go to www.google.com and type in MLA Handbook to learn how to cite your research information and sources. Each paper needs, **at the minimum**, to have **at least one** source from a book or e-book, **at least one** source from a magazine or periodical and at least one source from the internet. Be sure to cite your sources.

Big time extra credit for the oral presentation - an interview with a professional in the career on which you are writing. A picture would be a nice touch.
