

SOUTH CAROLINA LOTTERY TUITION ASSISTANCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

You have been awarded the South Carolina Lottery Tuition Assistance Program (LTAP). The amount of your award has been printed on the enclosed award letter.

Lottery Tuition Assistance Program Criteria:

- The student must be a South Carolina legal resident as defined in applicable State statutes governing the determination of residency for tuition and fee purposes;
- The student must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form each year and complete the process to determine eligibility for Federal Student Aid;
- The student must be enrolled as a Full-Time or Part-Time degree-seeking undergraduate student in an eligible program of study at a two year or technical college at the time of the grant disbursement;
- The student must not have been convicted of a felony or drug/alcohol violations;
- The student must not be in default or owe a refund on any Federal or State financial aid;
- The student must be making satisfactory academic progress toward the completion of degree program requirements;
- The student must not be eligible to receive the LIFE Scholarship;
- The student must not have already received a degree, certificate or diploma from an institution of Higher Education in the prior five-year period (except under certain conditions not applicable to USCL).

Continued Eligibility Requirements to Retain Lottery Tuition Assistance:

- The student must be meeting all above criteria;
- The student must maintain a 2.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) after attempting 24 credit hours by the end of each academic year.

Award Amount:

The Lottery Tuition Assistance Program actual award amounts are dependent upon the number of eligible students and the amount of funding available for the academic year. Lottery Tuition Assistance may not exceed the cost of in-state tuition. Any federal and state grants must be awarded first before determining the eligibility for Lottery Tuition Assistance that can be used toward the cost-of-tuition only.

Award Disbursements:

The Lottery Tuition Assistance Program award will be disbursed at the beginning of the Fall, Spring and Summer Terms respectively.

It will be necessary for you to sign, date and return the enclosed required “Certification and Affidavit Form”.
