REQUIRED CERTIFICATION AND AFFIDAVIT

As a *State Need Based Grant or LIFE Scholarship* recipient, I certify that I have not been convicted of any felonies. Further, I certify that I have not been convicted of an alcohol or drug-related misdemeanor offense during the preceding calendar year defined as 12 months from the date of the start of school for the period of this award. If I am adjudicated delinquent or am convicted or pled guilty or nolo contendere to any felonies or any second or subsequent alcohol or drug related misdemeanor offenses under the laws of South Carolina or any other state or under the laws of the United States, I agree to notify the Financial Aid Office by the start of school. I hereby give permission for a background check to be conducted to verify the above. I understand additional information may be requested after the background check has been conducted.

Any false information provided by the student or any attempt to expend any State Need Based Grant or LIFE Scholarship for unlawful purposes or any purpose other than in payment or reimbursement for the cost of tuition and mandatory fees at the institution authorized to award the funds will be cause for immediate cancellation of the grant or scholarship received. Any student who has obtained a grant or scholarship through means of a willfully false statement or failure to reveal any material fact, condition, or circumstances affecting eligibility will be subject to applicable civil or criminal penalties, including retroactive loss of the grant or scholarship.
