January 1	2009-2010 FAFSA available online at http://www.fafsa.ed.gov . Be sure to: 1) Complete 2008 taxes, 2) file early, 3) sign with a PIN, 4) enter USCL's School Code: 003453
April 15	Financial Aid Priority Deadline for USC Lancaster to receive the results of your 2009-2010 FAFSA (for applications received on or before this date, all other documentation is needed by April 30 th)
June-July	2009-2010 Financial Aid Awards packaged. Award Letter Notifications will be e-mailed or mailed.
July 30	Financial Aid Awarding Deadline for Fall 2009. The FAFSA and all required documentation must be received and complete by this date in order to be awarded in time to pay the Fall Term bill. <small>You may still file after this date, but aid will not be ready until after the bill due date.</small>
Mid-August	Mail-in payment deadline for fall 2009 tuition and fees.
August 17 & 18	Fall registration and walk-in fee payment. Financial aid must be applied to pay your bill on VIP. Any portion of the bill not covered by Financial Aid must be paid by this date.
August 20	Fall classes begin
August 26	Last day to register, change schedule or drop a course without a grade of "W" in the 16 week session. Please confirm drop dates for your classes on VIP. Before making changes to your schedule please contact the Financial Aid Office.
September 7	Labor day - No classes
